It is a qualitative research, analysis and synthesis from academic documents, books, research, in-depth interviews. Including organizing a group discussion forum from experts. There should be policies regarding farming problems, energy problems the problem of falling agricultural product prices. 3) Using Buddhist principles to integrate, for example, political parties use Principles of Aparihaniyadhamma 7, Saraniyadhamma 6 and Principles 6. Political party leaders use the principles of Brahmavihahara 4, Dasapitharadhamma 10, Abaya Mukha 6, Agati 4. And the characteristics of individuals who represent political parties use the principles of Devadhamma 2, Abaya Mukha 6, Loka Dhamma 4 and the Threefold 3, the political side of political parties uses the principles of Iddhipada 4, Sanghahavatthu 4, and Agati 4, and the needs of the people use the principles. The Noble Eightfold Path, Sangha Vatthu 4, Abya Mukha 6, and Loka Dhamma 4, New formats and knowledge is the 5Ps model, which has the following details: P (Party) P (Party's Leader) P (Personality) P (Policy) and P (People's Require)

It plays an important role in the development of society and the nation. The most important part of obtaining good public policy is that it comes from the process of studying and analyzing public policy according to academic principles (Kenaphoom. S, 2021 pp. 1-19) .The general condition of policy-making among Thai political parties has more complicated and diverse factors especially for reasons that are tied to external social and political movements rather than being tied to the leaders and leaders within the party at the same time, the measurement of success will shift weight to influencing society and politics. The sole goal is to get elected political party policies often have the characteristics of "selling dreams" and are unable to actually solve people's problems. In the past it can be said that the study of policy making by political parties has only the aim or the goal of only the results and losses in elections rather than the determination of policies that can actually solve problems in the local area or society.

Currently, Songkhla Province There is a problem regarding encroachment on public land because there is an area next to the sea. The villagers' main occupation is fishing. There is also the problem of price disparity in agricultural and fishery products. Products from rice farming, palm plantations, and rubber plantations have low prices, as well as problems with tourism promotion that lacks sincerity and consistency from the government, etc. All of these are factors that affect the slow development. The policy determination of political parties before the election is the policy that must lead to the solution of the problem. and brought to support the needs of solving problems of the people Both seafood products, latex, and rice have fallen in price, as well as tourism. Investment in various fields is still a problem in people's lives. Decisions of the general voters in Songkhla Province Policy is therefore extremely important.

Methodology

Consistent with Phuriwat's research Punyawutpreeda (2021, Abstract) has conducted research on Development of policy-making mechanisms for Thai political parties The results of the research found that: 1) The general conditions and problems and obstacles related to policy formulation of Thai political parties have complex factors and more diverse and dispersed especially for reasons based on social movements external politics rather than relying on leaders and leaders within the party. 2) The policy-making mechanism of Thai political parties requires that political parties be sincere in solving problems seriously. 3) Developing the policy-making mechanism of Thai political parties by adopting the 4 principles of Iddhipada. Use it as a guideline for policy making. The knowledge gained from the research indicates that the essence of the development of policy-making mechanisms of Thai political parties is It begins with policy formation from political party ideology. Leads to the process of determining political policy within the framework specified in the Constitution. Next is a policy decision. Ideas and guidelines for working with party policies consistent with and for the benefit of the nation and the people Adhere to the democratic system with the King as Head of State.

Components of political party policy making that affect people's decisions in exercising their rights to elect members of the House of Representatives in Songkhla Province." The research results found that Policy determination of political parties in Songkhla Province Those involved rely on two important factors as follows: The first is the basic component factor. 

Can be arranged in descending order as follows: qualifications of candidates, policy, political party and campaigning and personal media Hypothesis testing found that gender, education level, occupation, monthly income no relationship with factors affecting the decision to elect members of the House of Representatives in Pathum Thani Province, which did not go according to According to the assumptions set for age It has a relationship with factors affecting the decision to elect members of the House of Representatives in Pathum Thani Province with statistical significance at the 0.05 level, which is in accordance with Assumptions set.

The research found that the 4 Sangha Vatthus are tools or principles that help bring together many people to live happily together. It is a tool to help eliminate conflicts that occur, allowing people to live together with love. It can be used from the family level to the society level. It is fairness that will create happiness. In the city and the nation. If anyone adheres to this principle of Sangha Vatthu, I am sure that I will be loved and respected by my co-workers and the general public. It is also consistent with Chutiphon's research. Wongamornwit, Termsak Thongin and Suraphon Suyaphrom (2020, Abstract) found that political ethics consists of 1) the aspect of goodness; Adhere to it as a guideline for working, be diligent and patient. 2) Accuracy. Be transparent Consider the success of the work. 3) Appropriateness. Give importance to solving problems of the people, and the application of the 4 principles of Secular Dhamma, namely 1) the principle of truth, managing work with transparency and be a good example. 2) The principle of using intelligence. Give people the opportunity to participate in planning. 3) The principle of tolerance is patience. Perform duties with diligence. 4) Principles: Sacrifice, be patient, and see the benefits of the people.

Knowledge gained from research is the knowledge of the 5Ps Model as follows: P1 = Party (refers to the party). Political parties are an important component of public policy in a democracy. There are 6 roles of political parties (Somchai Phakapaswiwat, 2003, page 190) as follows: 1) The duty of giving political direction (Orientation Function) 2) The duty of gathering together people with common ideas (Aggregation Function) 3) Duty to spread values (Socialization Function) 4) Duty to represent the people (Representation Function) 5) The duty of selecting political personnel (Recruitment Function) 6) The duty of creating legitimacy (Legitimacy Function) P2 = Party's leader means the party leader or head of a political party is a person who holds an important position in a political party. By performing duties according to law and according to the regulations of that political party according to the Organic Act on Political Parties. Its job is to manage the party's relations with the general public and lead competition with political rivals. And the important thing is It is the center of awareness of people's problems, with representatives of the party, both MPs and general party members, as the link. Gradually it becomes a driving force and a force in regulating the members of the party. P3 = Personality refers to the individual or party representative. There are 2 types of candidates for election to the House of Representatives: 1) the type of constituency in which constituency? There must be a branch of a political party or a representative of a political party in the province that has an area of responsibility in that constituency. In submitting candidates for the election of members of the House of Representatives on a constituency basis in any constituency, the political party shall send candidates for election from those selected from the political party branches, or a representative of a political party in the province that has an area of responsibility in that constituency is a candidate for election. 2) Sending candidates for the election of members of the House of Representatives in the form of a list to political parties to prepare a list of names. To send to political party branches or representatives of political parties in the province, taking into account candidates from various regions and equality between men and women, the committee will determine the minimum ratio of male and female candidates that political parties must have. You can also submit to run for election. In the event that any political party is unable to send candidates according to the said ratio The reasons must be informed to the general public before the election application day. P4 = Policy means policy is a message that is broadly defined as a guideline for political party decision-making. It has important characteristics: 1) The policy is a broadly defined message with general implications. This may be specified in spoken or written language. 2) Policy is a directional framework for the executive and operational departments of political parties to use as goals or goals in their operations. Including being a guideline for decision-making by those involved and 3) Policy is not a method of operations but a conceptual framework used to set guidelines for achieving goals. or needs that have been determined as important. P5 = People's Require means the needs of the people. What is most evident and concrete every time there is an election is that the people want to nominate their chosen representatives to act in order to solve the problems of living. On solving poverty problems Regarding solving housing problems, solving problems, solving problems of insecurity in life and property. Solve political conflicts, etc. and develop and lead the nation to progress This is said is the demand of the people for the political sector, especially political parties that present policies to solve various problems, which is what the people hope for politicians and political parties.
